This deed made this the first
day of January 1884 between H
E Wall and S Kate Wall his wife
of the first part and H E Barron
of the second part; Witnesseth, that
for and in consideration of the sum
of Ten thousand Dollars in hand
paid the said H E Wall by the said
H E Barron, his receipt whereof is
hereby acknowledged the said H E
Wall and S Kate his wife do grant
bargain sell and convey with general
warranty unto the said H E Barron
the following property to wit; Part of
Lot Number 41 Judah Candlish's
Survey of the Town of Newmarket Virginia
fronting twenty four feet on the
East side of Main Street and
running back one hundred and fifty
feet, together with all the improvements
on said Lot, it being the same
property conveyed to said H E Wall
deed from B S Hooper as of the
16th day of Octo 1872 and recorded
Deed Book 35 page 127 in Briscoe's
County Court books Office, N. Va. the
