On or before the first day of June 1902
I promise to pay to Paullett Son & Co one hundred
and fifty dollars for the rent of the farm
in the County of Prince Edward the same farm
they purchased of Capt J. W. Southall for the
present year 1901. and I hereby promise to
protect & cultivate said farm in the same
way as I would my own farm. the agreement
is made that the tobacco lot near the river
can be cultivated in corn but no other tobacco
lots ^{not} to be cultivated in corn

and I hereby waive the benefit of my
homestead exemption as to the above
debt Witness my hand & seal. This
the 2nd day July 1901
