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

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

On the 25<sup>th</sup>. December 1898  
we hereby promise and bind ourselves, our  
heirs &c. to pay to Paulin Son & Co. or order  
the just & full sum of Two Hundred  
Dollars for rent of the "H. W. Southall" tract  
of land lying North of road leading through  
the old Village of Jamestown for the year 1898.  
And we hereby agree that the terms and  
conditions of Contract or article of agreement made  
14<sup>th</sup> September 1896. for rent of place for year  
1897, shall hold good and in full force  
for year 1898 in every particular therein  
mentioned. And as to the above debt we  
hereby waive the benefit of our homestead  
and all other exemptions. Given under  
our hands and seals this 2nd day of  
November 1897.
