of the county of Pr Edward and State of Virginia, for the sum of (\$26⁰⁰)
Twenty Six Dollars in hand paid to me by
~~_____~~ of Paulett, Son & Co., of the town of Farmville, Va., the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have this
day sold to them the following named and described personal property to-wit:

One dark bay Stallion, aged 8 yrs. old, named
"George"; one sorrel mare, aged 10 yrs. old named
"Jennie"; one Red & white cow, aged 6 yrs. named
"Lillie" & one ^{cow} ~~mare~~ cow (Red & white) aged 6 months
named "Billie"



Which said personal property I hereby promise and bind myself to keep in good order and condition and deliver the
same to said Paulett, Son & Co., whenever they may call for them.
