Dear Florence

Will ^{write} a little I am not
well at all but Mr. Boyer went
home Monday, Ralph wanted to
stay, we had all the boys Sunday
Blind & Carl came, and James & Ed
came Sunday noon. Said Lora
is coming in July. Virgie said
she started Doris a dress two or
three weeks ago, a little longer
dress, did you get that kind?

We have goods for Nelson & Doris.
Send us some patterns, Clyde has
goods left from a dress she
wants to make for Doris.

When you write to Virgie direct
your letter to 60 W. St, it is not
Main St. We had an awfull
rain Sunday eve but not so
much wind, rained again
yesterday eve. It was so dry

they could not get the pea land
in good order at all, Lawrence &
family plowed Monday & yesterday
till it rained in the back field, &
they have a lot to do yet before
they get peas all sowed,

& Hope you are all well
Write soon
