The minutes of the April 11, 2002, Senate meeting were approved as distributed.

Dr. Goetz introduced the newly elected members: Dr. Carolyn Craft, Dr. Wayne McWee, Dr. Darryl Poole, Mr. Chris Register, and Mr. Bill Stuart and announced the reelected members: Dr. Chuck Blauvelt, Dr. Jená Burges, Dr. David Coles, Dr. Jackie Hall, Dr. Charles Kinzer, and Dr. Betty Jo Simmons.

Dr. Simmons moved that the Senate approve for graduation all those candidates who have fulfilled the graduation requirements for their respective degrees. The motion was seconded and passed.

For the EPC, Dr. Burger moved the approval of the following changes in the Natural Sciences graduate program:

1. MS in Environmental Studies
2. Redefine methods to administer comprehensive examination
3. Course categories from name "field component" to "electives"
4. Change number of credits in various components categories including a reduction in the number of hours required for the field/lab/research from 18-10
5. Enst 550 Biostatistic from classroom component to field research component
6. Enst 605 change from elective to requirement.
7. Change course prefixes from Enst to Biol, Chem, or Easc.

The motion passed. Dr. Burger then moved the following statement for graduate studies:

"Graduate students not admitted to a degree, licensure or certificate program are expected to meet and maintain the same academic standards as students in those programs."

The motion passed.

Dr. Burger then moved, on behalf of the Senior Honors Research Committee, that the minimum GPA for admission to the program be raised from 2.7 to 3.0. The motion carried.

Dr. Burger moved the addition of Chemistry 270 to the chemistry core and the creation of Chemistry 361, Inorganic. The motion carried.
