Dr. Howe called the spring faculty meeting to order at 3:30 p.m. In the absence of a quorum he proceeded to his report on the year's work to date of the Faculty Senate.

Items considered include

- Criteria for the election of senators

- Book store concerns about the ordering and pricing of texts and materials

- The uses of student activity fees

- Progress toward Division I athletics

- Approval of the policy on speaking-intensive courses

- Numerous curricular changes and new courses

- Approval of Safety Policies and Procedures

Work still in progress includes revisions on the Promotion and Tenure Policies and Procedures, development of an intellectual property policy, and work of the Governance Committee studying revision of the committee descriptions.

Dr. Howe asked all those present to serve as a special committee choosing someone to serve as representative to the Faculty Senate until an election can be held in the fall. Dr. Hall moved that Dr. John Arehart serve. The motion was seconded and passed.
